





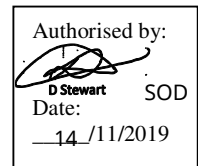

2020 BMX South Queensland Shootout Series, Battle of the Bridge

Event Guidelines for Riders:

- 1) The 2020 Shootout Series is to be run over seven (7) stages.
- 2) Pro Straights or 8m Hills will not be used at any Shootout Stages. Refer #23 for Stage 1 Special Event.
- 3) Riders may nominate into Race Categories, as per the current BMXA Rule Book, including Novice.
- 4) Three (3) Registered Riders constitute a class. Gender Equity Applies.
- 5) A rider may enter into their age group, as per year of birth. All open riders may enter above their age group, but a rider must compete in the minimum number of qualifying stages in a single series class to attain an award. Sprocket riders must stay in the Sprocket Category as per the current BMXA Rule Book.
- 6) Scoring method,
 - a. Motos, 100pts = 1st, 98pts = 2nd, 96pts = 3rd, 94pts = 4th through to 2pts = 50th
 - b. Qualifiers, 0points
 - c. Finals, 100pts = 1st, 95pts = 2nd, 90pts = 3rd, 85pts = 4th, 80pts = 5th, 75pts = 6th, 70pts = 7th, 65pts = 8th.
 - i. Final Points for classes of 8 riders or less, will be awarded based on rider placings after 4 motos
- 7) The rider's best 5 stages over the series will be considered in the final points tally.
- 8) There will be a Bonus 50 Points awarded to stage 7 to each Rider's score who nominate and ride all 7 stages.
- 9) **There will be no double point stages during the 2020 Series.**
- 10) **A bonus 50 Points will be awarded for competing in Stage 2 & 6 of the Series.**
- 11) Each stage consists of **4 Motos, No Qualifiers or Finals.** (Mini Wheelers, Sprockets & Novice)
- 12) Each stage consists of **3 Motos, Qualifiers and Invitational Finals** (Age & Superclass)
- 13) **A rider must ride 5 out of 7 stages to qualify for a series award.**
 - a. **Classes receiving prize money are not entitled to a series award**
 - b. **Additional memento awards maybe awarded during individual stages**
- 14) A rider who nominates into a stage of the series must take the gate, to be scored in that stage.
- 15) Series Scores will be posted on bmxsouthqld.org by Wednesday evening of the following week. In the event of a delay in scoring due to exceptional circumstances, a notice will be posted on the BMX South Queensland Social Media.
- 16) **Whatever Race Number you start the series should be your number for the whole series. Changes to Race Numbers need to be approved by the Series Secretary prior to a racing with an alternative Race Number.**
- 17) Prize Money will be paid by EFT. It is rider's responsibility to ensure a current BSB and Bank Account is provided to the Event Co-ordinator prior to the conclusion of Stage 7. Online Form available <https://tinyurl.com/y9jumd6o>
- 18) BMX South Queensland Athlete Development Squads will be selected from the 2020 Shootout Series and the 2020 BMX South Queensland Championship. Please refer to the BMX South Queensland Athlete Development Squad Selection Guidelines for further information.
- 19) There is to be no drinking of alcohol at any stages of the Shootout Series Events. There will be designated Smoking areas set aside away from the main competition and warm-up areas. These will be announced on the day of the event.
- 20) BMX South Queensland and their appointed officials may remove any rider, parent, or spectator from the venues at any time. BMX South Queensland reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.
 - a. All riders, parents and spectators are required to follow any reasonable direction provided by Staff contracted by BMX South Queensland to provide support services. Eg Medical, Security. Failure to follow these directions may result in removal from the venue or exclusion from competition.
 - b. All riders, parents and spectators are required to follow any reasonable direction provided by staff or contractors of the Sleeman Sports Complex. Failure to follow these directions may result in removal from the venue or exclusion from competition.
- 21) BMX South Queensland Committee and accredited officials reserve the right to modify the event schedule due to unforeseen circumstances. Eg. Weather. Such changes will be published on the BMX South Queensland Social Media prior to scheduled racing.
- 22) Top Gun Men & Top Gun Women are special classes within the Shootout Series. It is recommended for ages 14 to 15years as a transition class to SuperClass. Nomination in an additional age class is not required.
- 23) **BMX South Qld Cup Challenge** will be a designated Special Event within Stage 1 of the 2020 Shootout Series.
 - a. BMX South Queensland will offer Superclass Men & Women Classes.
 - b. Riders eligible to nominate as per the current Australian Rule Book for Superclass.
 - c. The designated track will include the 8m Hill and Pro-straight of the Sleeman SX.
 - d. Racing for the Special Event will be as per the current UCI World Cup format using the BEM scoring program
 - e. Equal Prize Money will be offered for both the Men and Women Superclasses independent of the 2020 Shootout Series prize money and awards.



Transponder Disclaimer

I, the undersigned, for myself and for my heirs, personal representatives and assigns, do hereby release and forever discharge the controlling bodies, organizers, officials, members property owners, employees and any other person, firm or corporation charged with responsibility or liability, from all or any claims, demands, damages, costs and expenses, loss of service and any other actions arising from any act or occurrence and particularly on account of ALL PERSONAL INJURY, DISABILITY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR LOSS OF ANY KIND that I may hereafter sustain as a result of participation in any event, as a competitor official or spectator conducted by any club or organization affiliated with the official controlling bodies of BMX in Queensland. I fully understand the nature of the activities to be conducted and acknowledge the hazards of the said activities. I voluntarily assume

The risk of injury to my person, property and the property of others. In the event of any injury I hereby give my consent for proper medical treatment to be administered. By signing this document, you and those in your company, agree to comply with and be bound by the Code of Behaviour as it relates to riders, parents, spectators and officials. I agree to allow the site first aid officers to release any relevant information to BMX Queensland in the event I require first aid attention, this information being for insurance purposes. I am aware that any photographs, still or moving, that may be taken during the event may be published and used for publicity and promotional purposes by BMX QLD Inc. Where the race organiser provides/hires transponders for electronic lap timing, it is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike. Transponders must be returned to Registration at the conclusion of the event and failure to do so will incur a cost to the rider of \$155 plus cost.

Event Guidelines for Host Clubs:

- ✓ To have their track up to an Open Day race standard and compatible with the Mylaps timing system.
- ✓ Club facilities should have capacity to service 2000-2500 riders and spectators.
- ✓ To make available to the BMX South Queensland Nominated Officials; the Gate Area, Nominations & Scoring Facilities, Finish Line, Commentary and any additional areas that the Event Co-ordinator requests.
- ✓ Suitable Area for First Aid Operations provided by BMX South Queensland.
- ✓ The Club is to supply bottled cold water for the Event Officials.
- ✓ The Host club will be able to hold raffles on the day once racing has commenced. Where the Zone has a product through Sponsorship the Zone will sell raffle tickets at each stage.
- ✓ The Host club is to supply track maintenance crew at all times throughout the running of the event.
- ✓ If the host club does not have adequate toilet facilities on their grounds, they must provide portable toilets at the clubs cost.
- ✓ The Host club to make the necessary arrangements with the Local Councils/Authorities to ensure the Event complies to local requirements for hosting an event of this size.
- ✓ All Vendors must be approved by the BMX South Queensland prior to the event.
- ✓ These Guidelines can be amended by BMX South Qld Committee from time to time without notice.
